He confirmed that KCC were still pressing ahead with the background work to ascertain the need for the Relief Road, however since the meeting MBC were not working with KCC.

The Chairman asked about route options for the Relief Road and it was confirmed that these were still being considered and at some point, next year KCC would consult with Parish Councils.

He referred to a letter from Helen Whateley MP that had offered to attend a meeting with MBC and KCC.

Councillor Cooke stated that MBC had declined to attend this and therefore to date no date had been arranged.

Councillor Cooke reported on a forthcoming Public Consultation to review the KCC subsidised Buses and stated that at present this was only a consultation and no matters had been considered.
